Kasarabada Subramanya Sharma is S/O of K Venkateswara Rao and Suseela. He is a B.Sc, M.A (Telugu), MLi.Sc and retired as Asst. Librarian of Acharya Nagarjuna University. One of the few lucky ones who had his passion and profession amalgamated in reading, writing and also classifying a mega library with more than a half a million books, periodicals, magazines, old manuscripts and journals in his service duration.

He writes in with his "Pen name" of Radha Manoharan, inspired by his wife Radha. (Radha Manoharan is Lord Krishna's one of many names, meaning – Manohar – One who stole the heart, of Radha).

He penned around 15 novels, 20 features, 35 Haikus, 25 Poetic works, 40 Dramas in All India Radio, 30 Short stories in Radio, 30 trans literary works from Kannada, Tamil, Bengali, Hindi, 800 articles, travelogues and is a featured writer with more than 12 published spiritual articles in "Antaryami" of Daily News paper Eenadu .
